Table with columns: REGISTERED NUMBER AND DATE OF FILING, DATE OF DEATH, FULL NAME OF THE DECEASED, Sex, Color, Single, Married, etc., AGE, PLACE OF DEATH, CAUSE OF DEATH. Entries include Elwood L McJannet, Samuel Waterman, William I Wheeler, Charles H Culver, William Aubil, William Court, Jr., Jason H Scott, Bessie Young, Ida M Cook, Emma E Sierdy.

*Use abbreviations in these columns: Sex, M, male; F, female. Color, W, white; B, black; M, mulatto; I, Indian. CIVIL STATUS: S, single; M, married; W, widow or widower; D, divorced. The data on Certificate is regard to age at marriage, number of children, etc., may be entered under name of deceased, if desired, no special column being reserved on Register therefor.
